

Samsung Galaxy Note7 Banned From All U.S. Flights

The Federal Aviation Administration, the U.S. Department of Transportation and the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration has issued an emergency order **banning all Samsung Galaxy Note7 devices from flying onboard any aircraft in the United States.**

The ban will be effective beginning Oct. 15 at 12 p.m. Eastern time for all US flights. No original Note7s, as well as the replacements devices distributed since September, will be allowed in the cabin, checked or carry-on luggage, air cargo or air mail.

That means customers flying Oct. 15 or later must leave Note7s at home.

The TSA will be assisting with identifying the devices during the screening process at all airports. The DOT and FAA are asking airlines to not allow boarding to any passenger who has a Note7 in their possession.
