Delta Connection Carrier SkyWest Airlines to Celebrate New Service in Tallahassee, Fla.

ST. GEORGE, UTAH, Jan. 7, 2002 -- Delta Connection carrier SkyWest Airlines (Nasdaq: SKYW) will celebrate daily, nonstop regional jet service between Tallahassee, Fla., and Dallas/Fort Worth with a ribbon-cutting ceremony at 11:30 a.m. on Tuesday, Jan. 8. The event, hosted by the Tallahassee Regional Airport and Delta Connection, a subsidiary of Delta Air Lines (NYSE: DAL), will be at the Art Port Gallery in the airport terminal.

Nonstop SkyWest service between Tallahassee and Dallas/Ft. Worth began Jan.1 with two daily roundtrips. Flights are operated with Canadair regional jet (CRJ) aircraft. Known for its convenience, comfort, and speed, the CRJ carries passengers in a two-by-two seating arrangement; every seat is an aisle or window, with no middle seats. The plane can cruise at a speed of 530 mph at altitudes as high as 41,000 feet.

The Dallas/Fort Worth hub offers more than 200 Delta and Delta Connection flights to more than 60 cities. Delta Connection carriers include wholly owned subsidiaries Atlantic Southeast Airlines and Comair, and additional regional carriers ACA and SkyWest.
