DENVER, August 14, 2003 – SkyWest Airlines, a subsidiary of SkyWest, Inc. (NASDAQ: SKYW) is pleased to announce the promotion of Randy Mulvey to the Regional Director of the Mountain Region. As a United Express carrier, SkyWest currently operates 66 daily flights to 30 cities from Denver International Airport. Passengers who fly on SkyWest's United Express service from Denver will earn frequent flyer miles on United's Mileage Plus program.

SkyWest Airlines is the nation's largest independently operated regional carrier and carried 8.23 million passengers last year. The US Department of Transportation has recognized SkyWest as the number one on-time airline in the United States three out of the last four months. SkyWest operates as Continental Connection, Delta Connection and United Express carriers under marketing agreements with Continental Airlines, Delta Air Lines, and United Airlines respectively. System-wide, SkyWest has approximately 5,500 employees and serves a total of 100 cities in 27 states and two Canadian provinces with more than 1,100 daily departures.
