Airport Arrival and Check-in – SkyWest recommends that travelers arrive at the airport approximately two hours prior to their flight's scheduled departure time. However, it's always a good idea to contact the airline about flight status, appropriate arrival time, availability of curbside check-in and proper e-ticket documentation.

Security Screening – Be aware that electronic items (laptops, cell phones, etc.) are subject to additional X-ray/screening. Remove all metal objects prior to passing through metal detectors. Be prepared to show a government-issued photo ID, along with a boarding document with flight departure for the current date to enter the secured area beyond the screening checkpoint. Keep in mind that procedures may vary from airport to airport because of logistics, The Department of Homeland Security's Alert Status, etc.
