SkyWest Resumes Seasonal Service between West Yellowstone and Salt Lake City

St. George, UT, June 1, 2005 – SkyWest Airlines, a subsidiary of SkyWest, Inc. (NASDAQ: SKYW), is pleased to announce that they will resume seasonal Delta Connection service for the eighteenth straight year between West Yellowstone, Montana and Salt Lake City, Utah. Flying under the Delta Connection banner, SkyWest will operate two daily round-trip flights with the 30-passenger Embraer Brasilia turboprop aircraft beginning on June 7 with service through September 30. The enhanced 2005 schedule also offers an additional round-trip flight on Saturdays and Sundays.

Chris Wong-Cervantes, SkyWest's West Yellowstone Station Manager, said, "We are excited to open the West Yellowstone Airport with seasonal summer service, and we're looking forward to serving the community of West Yellowstone with local air service again."
