## **SkyWest Airlines Offers Special Senior Fares from St. George to Salt Lake City**

Effective August 1, this special fare of \$75 each way is extended to all senior citizens (65+ years of age).

To qualify, seniors must be 65 years of age or older and show government-issued photo ID. Special fare tickets must be purchased at the St. George Municipal Airport Delta Connection counter.

SkyWest Airlines is celebrating 35 years in 2007, marking its maiden flight from St. George to Salt Lake City in June 1972.
