SkyWest Airlines Announces Service Date for Cedar City – Salt Lake City Service

ST. GEORGE, Utah, November 5, 2007 – SkyWest Airlines, a subsidiary of SkyWest, Inc. (NASDAQ: SKYW), announces that Delta Connection service between Cedar City and Salt Lake City will begin January 8, 2008 utilizing the Embraer-manufactured EMB 120 aircraft.
