SkyWest Issues an Apology to the Smith Family

St. George, UT, June 10, 2008 – SkyWest Airlines, a wholly-owned subsidiary of SkyWest, Inc. (NASDAQ: SKYW), issues the following apology to the Smith family.

The unaccompanied minor travel program is important to us, and we take it very seriously. We have a check and balance system, both at the gate and in the cabin, to ensure a child is never unaccompanied, especially when changing planes. However, it appears those systems failed on Saturday and a child deplaned alone. Although our agent stepped in quickly to resolve the situation, it certainly should have been handled better, and we apologize to the Smith family for their distress. We understand the trust parents place in our airline when utilizing the unaccompanied minor program, and are investigating the specifics of this case to ensure parents and their children receive the care they expect when flying SkyWest.
