****FARE FACTS:** Fares are for travel on SkyWest Delta Connection flights between Twin Falls, Idaho and Salt Lake City only. The \$75.00 one way fare will be available for purchase March 3 – April 25, 2008 for travel through May 31, 2008. Passengers must purchase the ticket 21 days in advance to acquire the fare. Tickets purchased through Delta reservation offices are \$15 per ticket higher and tickets purchased at airport ticket counters are \$20 per ticket higher.
