North Bend, Ore., June 25, 2010 – United Airlines announced the addition of a third daily round-trip flight between North Bend and San Francisco, and a second daily round-trip flight between North Bend and Portland, giving travelers in this northwest region of the Evergreen State greater travel flexibility. The United Express flights, operated by SkyWest Airlines, increases the airline’s current North Bend service to 134 departures each month.
